

VSF is an articulated partnership of organizations, academic and cultural institutions, public and private enterprises interested in working for the sustainable future of Venice and its territory.





5 minutes by water taxi from **Tronchetto Parking**.




10 minutes by water taxi from Santa Lucia Train Station and Piazzale Roma.
